

## Mission and Social Concerns Committee

- **Name of Committee:** Mission and Social Concerns Committee
- **Purpose:** To educate and enable church members to do mission work and social action.
- **Type of activity:** Supply congregations with information about social concerns, plan and implement mission opportunities (work at Mo-Val) within and outside of the United States.
- **Meetings:** Quarterly or as needed with the time and date determined by the members of the committee.
- **Length of commitment:** Initial 2 year term, may be re-nominated and serve a total of 6 years.
- **Expectations:** Members are expected to attend both committee and association meetings. There should be a willingness to be part of the body of Christ and to serve as part of God's realm on earth, demonstrating an outward sign of an inward faith.
- **Accountability:** Access to the Conference Minister. We report to the Eastern Association Council.
- **Qualifications:** Demonstrate a willingness to serve and an interest in issues of mission and social concerns.
- **Support and Resources:** Access to the Conference Minister; Reports to the Eastern Association Council; May do fund raising to finance mission opportunities.
